The Mayor or a member of the Council may however, inform the individual participating in the Citizens' Input session that his/her topic may be placed on a future meeting agenda or they may direct said individual to the appropriate City department head who can address their issue! To participate in the Citizens' Input session, an individual must sign up with the City's meeting registrar prior to the start of the meeting. Discussion time will be limited to five (5) minutes per individual registered.

8. Public Hearing.
- A. A public hearing to consider a request from Nancy Padgett and others for water services outside the City limits located on Johnson Road in the unincorporated Wichita County.

9. Resolution.
- A. A resolution of the City Council of the City of Iowa Park, Texas approving a negotiated settlement between the Atmos Cities Steering Committee (“ACSC”) and Atmos Energy Corp., Mid-Tex Division regarding the Company’s 2017 rate review mechanism filings; declaring existing rates to be unreasonable; adopting tariffs that reflect rate adjustments consistent with the negotiated settlement; finding the rates to be set by the settlement tariffs to be just and reasonable and in the public interest; requiring reconciliation and rate adjustments if federal income tax rates change; terminating the RRM process for 2018 pending renegotiation of RRM terms and conditions; requiring the company to reimburse ACSC’s reasonable ratemaking expenses; determining that this ordinance was passed in accordance with the requirements of the Texas Open Meetings Act; adopting a savings clause; declaring an effective date; and requiring delivery of this resolution to the Company and the ACSC’s legal counsel. **(Res #17-12)**
