9. Resolution.
A. A resolution of the City Council of the City of Iowa Park, Texas, approving a negotiated settlement between the Atmos Cities Steering Committee ("ACSC") and Atmos Energy Corp., Mid-Tex Division regarding the Company's 2020 Rate Review Mechanism Filing; declaring existing rates to be unreasonable; adopting tariffs that reflect rate adjustments consistent with the negotiated settlement; finding the rates to be set by the attached settlement tariffs to be just and reasonable and in the public interest; approving an attached exhibit establishing a benchmark for pensions and retiree medical benefits; approving an attached exhibit regarding amortization of regulatory liability; requiring the company to reimburse ACSC's reasonable ratemaking expenses; determining that this resolution was passed in accordance with the requirements of the Texas Open Meetings Act; adopting a savings clause; declaring an effective date; and requiring delivery of this resolution to the Company and the ACSC's legal counsel. **(Res #20-21)**
B. A resolution of the City Council of the City of Iowa Park, Texas accepting and approving the City of Iowa Park's reimbursement policy for use for use of Iowa Park Volunteer Fire Department member personal vehicles to respond to calls for fires and/or medical emergency services on behalf of the Iowa Park Volunteer Fire Department. **(Res #20-22)**
